## **BREICHA (POOL)**



(for 60-70 balls):

600 grams of dry chickpeas 2 bunches of fresh cilantro 2 onions 10 cloves of garlic Half a green hot pepper A quarter cup of water

#### Spices:

1 1/2 tablespoon ground cumin 2 tablespoons sesame 1 1/2 tablespoon salt 1/2 teaspoon baking soda

#### Directions:

- 1. Wash the chickpeas, soak in water for about 12 hours.
- 2. Filter and wash the grains.
- 3. Grind the chickpeas together with the cilantro, onions, garlic and hot pepper in a food processor.
- 4. Add the spices and water (including baking soda) and mix well.
- 5. Make balls.
- 6. Fry in deep oil.
